PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Park+ built its first secured truckstop in Langres, next to the A31 motorway in eastern France. This is a traditional stop for the international carriers traveling between Northern and Southern Europe.

This service is provided on a closed parking equipped with video surveillance and state of the art access control technology. On-site security guards are also monitoring and patrolling the premises.

In this truckstop, Park+ also offers new services dedicated to truck drivers, including a restaurant, a bar, a shop, a rest lounge, a launderette, showers and sanitary facilities.

Laid on a 5 hectares area, the Langres truckstop can accommodate up to 230 Heavy Good Vehicles.
